Space for God Recognizing His Presence

PREPARATION

The Lord declares:

Do not tremble; do not be afraid. Did I not proclaim my purposes for you long ago? You are my witnesses—is there any other God?

No! There is no other Rock-not one! -Amen- Isaiah 44:8

CONFESSION

Lord, if you kept a record of our sins, who, O Lord, could ever survive? **But you offer forgiveness, that we might learn to fear you.**

WORSHIP

I will meditate on your majestic, glorious splendor and your wonderful miracles. Your awe-inspiring deeds will be on every tongue;

I will proclaim your greatness. Everyone will share the story of your wonderful goodness; they will sing with joy about your right-eousness. Psalm 145:5-7

MEDITATION & CONTEMPLATION-Luke 24:35-49*

Then the two from Emmaus told their story of how Jesus had appeared to them as they were walking along the road, and how they had recognized him as he was breaking the bread. And just as they were telling about it, Jesus himself was suddenly standing there among them. "Peace be with you," he said. But the whole group was startled and frightened, thinking they were seeing a ghost!

"Why are you frightened?" he asked. "Why are your hearts filled with doubt? Look at my hands. Look at my feet. You can see that it's really me. Touch me and make sure that I am not a ghost, because ghosts don't have bodies, as you see that I do." As he spoke, he showed them his hands and his feet.

Still they stood there in disbelief, filled with joy and wonder. Then he asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?" They gave him a piece of broiled fish, and he ate it as they watched.

IN SOLITUDE AND/OR COMMUNITY

Read Slowly, several times.

Reflect What does the text say?

Respond How does it relate to my life?

Rest I welcome God's healing and renewal.

Then he said, "When I was with you before, I told you that everything written about me in the law of Moses and

the prophets and in the Psalms must be fulfilled." Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. And he said, "Yes, it was written long ago that the Messiah would suffer and die and rise from the dead on the third day. It was also written that this message would be proclaimed in the authority of his name to all the nations, beginning in Jerusalem: 'There is forgiveness of sins for all who repent.' You are witnesses of all these things.

"And now I will send the Holy Spirit, just as my Father promised. But stay here in the city until the Holy Spirit comes and fills you with power from heaven."

ANCHORING PRAYER

Your life and Your forgiveness fill me with joy and wonder.

REVIEW OF THE HEART

Where have I recognized the presence of Christ in my life? What confusion or doubt affects my faith in God?

WISDOM

O nations of the world, recognize the Lord, recognize that the Lord is glorious and strong. 1 Chronicles 16:28
