## Parent Flyer - Treasure Quest Lesson 1

**Lesson Goal:** The children will understand that everyone has sinned and that God has a plan to help us with our sin. **Main Point:** Sin Separates us From God!

**Bible Verse:** "For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard." Romans 3:23 (NLT)

This week your children helped us kick off a brand new series called Treasure Quest. They were also introduced to two characters on a mission to find the greatest treasure ever: Kit Windswept and Andi Bennett. Kit is used to the jungle and loves a challenge. Andi, on the other hand, is more comfortable back home researching. Kit called Andi to help decipher clues to find the treasure. They know that to find the treasure they must follow some special stones that they find in the jungle. However, each stone is a clue and in order to understand each clue they must study stories from the Bible. This first week, Kit and Andi found the sin stone and despite Andi's warning, Kit attempted to simply grab it. This sprung a trap and Kit's hand was stuck to the stone. Andi went on to explain that in order to free the stone, and Kit's hand, they would have to understand where sin came from.

Andi went on to tell the story of Adam and Eve from Genesis chapters 2 & 3. God created Adam and Eve and they were the very first human beings. They lived in the Garden of Eden where they walked with God and spent time with Him every day. The garden was perfect, they had everything they needed. God only gave them one rule to live by. There was a tree in the middle of the garden called "the tree of the knowledge of good and evil." They could eat from any tree they wanted except for that tree. One day a serpent spoke to Eve and tempted her to eat the fruit anyway. Eventually Eve agreed and ate the fruit. Adam was with her and ate some as well. At that moment they disobeyed God and committed the very first sin. As a result, they were kicked out of the garden and were separated from God. Since they were the very first human beings, their sin flows into us. We all sin and our sin separates us from God. After telling the story, Andi was able to unlock the trap and free Kit's hand along with the sin stone. On the back was a clue about next week when children will learn about God's plan to help us with sin.

Every part of this week's lesson was geared toward teaching your children about what sin is and how it separates us from God. Remind your children how serious sin is and that God has a plan to help us with our sin.
