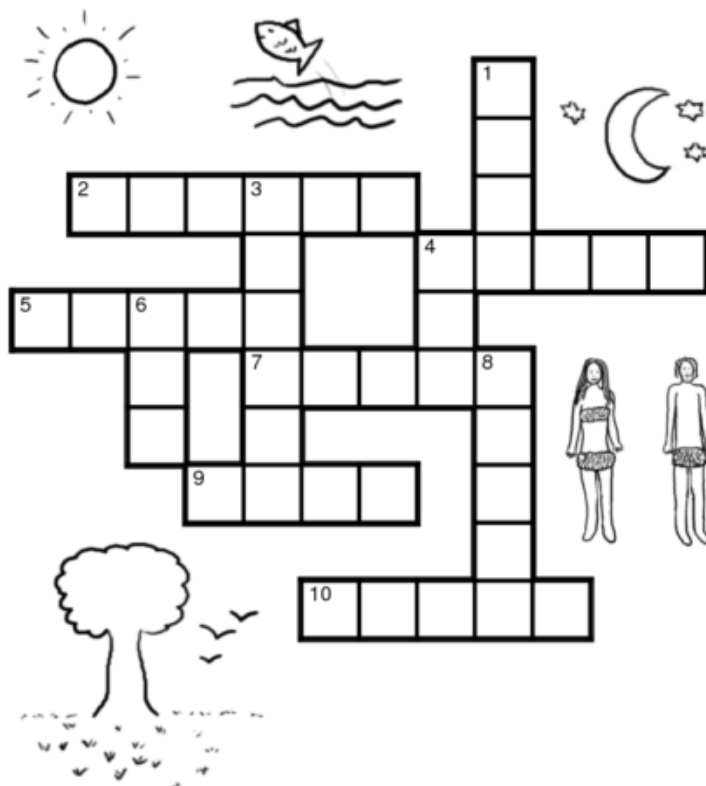

## PARENT FLYER: LESSON 1

**Lesson Goal:** The children will learn that God created all things and that it is our job to take care of what God has created.

**Main Point:** God Gave Us The World, So We Need To Take Care Of It!

**Bible Verse:** "Fill the earth and govern it." Genesis 1:28b (*NLT*)

This was the first week of our brand new series: Adventures In Science. This entire series is dedicated to helping your child explore the miracles and mysteries of God. This week your child met two very special characters here at the labs. The first is Dr. Petri Oppenheimerstein, a bumbling scientist trying desperately to win the Plutonium Award for Scientific Achievement. The second is Flask, an android assistant who tries to keep Oppenheimerstein on track. Today, Dr. Oppenheimerstein tried to invent a device that could create something from nothing. Obviously, the device failed miserably leaving Oppenheimerstein with no chance of getting the award this week.

The Science and Research Council then contacted Oppenheimerstein and explained that it is impossible for a device to create something from nothing. Only God can do that. Then the council chairman told the Bible Lesson, found in Genesis 1-2:3, of the creation of the world. Over the course of 6 days, God created day and night, sky, dry land, plants, the sun, the moon, all of the stars, fish, birds, animals and finally He created the first two human beings: Adam and Eve. And God created everything from nothing! He gave humans the responsibility of taking care of the world He created.

God gave us a tremendous gift when He created the world. Every game and activity this week was meant to remind your child how important it is for us to take good care of the world.
